

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 388

SHELTON CITY COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 307

WHEREAS, the Mason County Regional Planning Council on December 17, 1974 adopted in principal the Comprehensive Plan for Solid Waste Disposal for Mason County, which Plan was subsequently refined and finally adopted by that body on March 13, 1974, and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelton on January 31, 1974 as necessitated by compliance with existing laws and regulations, and upon expiration of a provisional burning permit issued by the Olympic Air Pollution Control Authority did cease operation of the former Shelton Disposal Site in N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 22, Range 4, and

WHEREAS, by mutual agreement Mason County accepted and continues to accept for disposal those solid wastes formerly handled at the City of Shelton disposal site including those solid wastes hauled by the City's regular "packer" collection truck, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Shelton to continue to dispose of solid wastes at the Mason County Solid Waste Landfill under the regulations, including equitable and uniform charges, as established by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County that Mason County does hereby agree to accept all solid wastes normally collected within the limits of Shelton and by the authority of the Shelton City Commission and to dispose of such solid wastes in accordance with current regulations and disposal charges as may be adopted by the Board from time to time in conformity with laws of the State and regulations of the Thurston-Mason Health District, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED jointly by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County and the Shelton City Commission that in order that the City of Shelton may participate proportionately in the continuing operating costs of the landfill, the terms and conditions of payment have been proposed and accepted as follows:

1. The City of Shelton does hereby agree to pay to the Mason County Public Works Department a disposal fee of Five and no/100 Dollars (\$5.00) per ton for solid waste so collected and accepted. Payment by the City of Shelton shall be quarterly, based upon the tonnage amount actually disposed of within the previous quarter.

2. Any significant deviation, upward or downward as experience may indicate, will cause this agreement to be renegotiated.

3. The charge per ton may be adjusted by action of the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County when actual cost records of landfill operation indicate such adjustment to be necessary or desirable and after mutual agreement by the City of Shelton.

4. Mason County shall furnish to the City of Shelton monthly cost accounting records of the landfill operation.

5. Any proposed increase in the disposal fees by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County shall be submitted to the City of Shelton Commission for review sixty (60) days prior to adoption.

6. This disposal agreement shall be for the initial period February 1, 1974 to December 31, 1974 and shall be automatically renewed for each succeeding twelve month period unless a request for termination by either the City of Shelton or Mason County be submitted to the other body on or before the first day of October of the then current year.
