

RESOLUTION NO. 391

ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on March 18, 1974, declaring that an unforeseen expense had arisen for which there is insufficient budget in the County Treasurer's 1974 Budget; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is in the best interest of Mason County that such expenditure is necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet it:

\$5,223.00, plus tax for the purchase of the following:

Recordak Motormatic Reader/Printer	-	\$3,260.00	
Recordak Portable Microfilmer	-	1,515.00	
Film	-	<u>448.00</u>	
Total			\$5,223.00 plus tax.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, April 1, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$5,223.00 plus tax must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
