

RESOLUTION NO. 401

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Laws of the 1973 Extraordinary Session of the State Legislature did make the following changes in dates on which Memorial Day and Veteran's Day are to be observed in the State of Washington:

Memorial Day - May 30th (rather than the last Monday in May)  
Veteran's Day - November 11th (rather than the last Monday in October)

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Mason County Commissioners to have Mason County observance of these two holidays in harmony with the State law;

THEREFORE, be it HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that Memorial Day will be observed on May 30th in Mason County, and Veteran's Day will be observed on November 11th, and that the County Courthouse will be closed on those two dates.
