

RESOLUTION NO. 402

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1973, the Board of County Commissioners did issue a Substantial Development Permit identified as Permit No. 61, in compliance with the Shoreline Management Act of 1971, to the Mason County Park & Recreation Board; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of the property upon which the Substantial Development Permit was issued reads as follows: "Southeast ten (10) acres of Government Lot 2, Section 34, Township 22 North, Range 2 West, W.M., Mason County, Washington at Mason Lake"; and

WHEREAS, the full legal description of said property for which a Substantial Development Permit was issued should also have correctly included the following legal description for the adjacent parcel: "Tracts 131, 132, 133 and 134, of Mading's Sunny Shore, Addition No. 5";

NOW, THEREFORE, be it HEREBY RESOLVED that the Substantial Development Permit issued by the Board of Mason County Commissioners on October 9, 1973 to the Mason County Park & Recreation Board, hereinbefore described as "Application No. 61", be HEREBY AMENDED to read as follows: "Southeast ten (10) acres of Government Lot 2, Section 34, Township 22 North, Range 2 West, W.M., Mason County, Washington at Mason Lake, AND Tracts 131, 132, 133 and 134, Plat of Mading's Sunny Shore Addition No. 5, Mason County, Washington."
