

RESOLUTION NO. 411

WHEREAS, in accordance with the "Federal Fair Labor Standards Act", which is also known as the "Federal Minimum Wage Law", and went into effect May 1, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, Washington, hereby sets the following policy for all Mason County Employees, except Public Safety Employees:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT: Effective July 1, 1974, the work week for all County employees will be established as from 12:01 A. M. Sunday to 12:00 P. M. Saturday of each week; and

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN: That from this date on, no Compensatory time will be allowed, and any time worked over forty hours during the established work week, will be compensated at the rate of time-and-one-half.
