

ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES
OF MASON COUNTY OFFICERS

WHEREAS, Washington Laws, 1973 1st Ex. Sess., Chapter 88 allows the Mason County Commissioners to establish the salaries of Mason County Officers;

AND WHEREAS, inflation and the increasing responsibilities and duties of the Mason County Officers mandate a salary increase and salary increments thereto;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mason County Board of County Commissioners:

Section 1. Salaries established for 1975, Auditor, twelve thousand five hundred dollars; Clerk, twelve thousand five hundred dollars; Treasurer, twelve thousand five hundred dollars; Assessor, twelve thousand five hundred dollars; Sheriff, fourteen thousand dollars; Prosecuting Attorney, twenty three thousand seven hundred dollars; Justice Court Judge, eleven thousand dollars.

Section 2. The salary of each Mason County Commissioner is hereby set as follows: (1) for 1975: twelve thousand five hundred dollars; (2) for 1976: thirteen thousand dollars; (3) for 1977: fourteen thousand dollars; PROVIDED, no Commissioner or replacement thereof serving in a current term of office shall have the benefit or advantage of the foregoing salary increases.

Section 3. Savings clause. If any provision of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

Section 4. Effective date and term. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage thereof and shall so remain until duly and lawfully amended or repealed.
