

RESOLUTION NO. 432

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on August 13, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient funds in the Office of Emergency Services's 1974 Budget; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

\$500.00 to cover the cost of painting, repairs and equipment for the Pickup Truck recently acquired through the State Excess Property program. (\$250.00 of this amount will be reimbursed to the Office of Emergency Services through the State.)

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget extension be held at 1:45 P. M., Monday, August 26, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$500.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
