

RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY NO. 433

WHEREAS, Mason County is imminently as well as continually from time to time in need of rock for rip rap, and

WHEREAS, the firm of Jonco, Inc. of Vancouver, Washington is now operating in the immediate vicinity and has proposed to blast at each of three sites, viz, "Camp 3 Quarry" (Simpson), "Mission Lake Quarry" (Pope & Talbot), "Dayton Peak Quarry" (Simpson), a minimum of 3,000 cubic yards at each site for 75¢ per cubic yard, and

WHEREAS, this proposal is very favorable to Mason County because the cost of mobilization from outside the area has been eliminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to prepare agreements with Jonco, Inc. for the production of this material.
