

RESOLUTION NO. 436
ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on September 10, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient funds in the Mason County Park Board's 1974 Budget; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

\$55,201.50 to cover the Mason Lake Park Project, which will be reimbursed by the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation in the form of a grant, after the funds have been expended on the project at the local level.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget extension be held at 11:00 A. M., Monday, September 23, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$55,201.50 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditures, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
