

RESOLUTION NO. 437
ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on September 10, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient funds in the Mason County General Administration Budget for 1974; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

\$235.00 to cover purchase of 1968 Chevrolet Pickup, Serial No. CE148Z135117, County Vehicle No. 33, from the County Road Department, to replace the General Administration pickup which was demolished in an accident on May 21, 1974.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget extension be held at 11:15 A. M., Monday, September 23, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$235.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
