

RESOLUTION NO. 440

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1974, the County Commissioners were advised that the County Treasurer had received the amount of \$309,944.49, which has been credited to the Federal Forest Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to allocate 50% of the Federal Forest Funds to the Mason County School Districts and 50% to the Mason County Road Fund; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 1974, the Board did receive from the Superintendent of Intermediate School District No. 113, his recommendations for the distribution of the 50% which goes to the various school districts of Mason County, in total amount of \$154,972.24;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the County Treasurer be hereby directed to credit the County Road Fund with \$154,972.25, and to make the following distribution of \$154,972.24 to the Mason County School District Funds as follows:
