

RESOLUTION NO. 445

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962 said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County roads, unless otherwise posted, and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on 5th Street, Plat of Union, Volume 1, Page 9, warrant a speed limit of 25 miles per hour:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said 5th Street in the Plat of Union be posted at 25 miles per hour effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 25 mile per hour signs on said roads in conformity herewith.
