

RESOLUTION NO. 448

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on October 22, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient funds in the County Assessor's 1974 Budget; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

\$4,500.00 for postage and \$185.00 for printing, making a total of \$4,685.00 to implement Chapter 187, Laws of 1974, entitled: "Revenue and Taxation of Timber and Forest Lands", passed in the First Extraordinary Session.

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget extension be held at 2:00 P. M., Monday, November 4, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount \$4,685.00 must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, and is to be used strictly for postage and printing for this purpose only, in accordance with the laws governing budget extensions.
