

RESOLUTION NO. 450

ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNTY ROADS
Plat of Rustlewood

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish as county roads, those roads as shown and dedicated to the public in the Plat of Rustlewood, as recorded in Volume 8 of Plats, pages 108-110, records on file in the office of the Mason County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and public hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report submitted by the Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the above mentioned plat roads be established as part of the Mason County Road System, and the Mason County Engineer be directed to proceed with said project according to plans on file.
