

RESOLUTION NO. 453

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 381, the Board did establish a certain table of charges for solid waste handled by the Mason County Solid Waste Disposal Landfill, and

WHEREAS, the County plans in the very near future to initiate collection service at three outlying stations, Belfair, Union and Hoodspout, to serve householders in those areas, and

WHEREAS, operational costs for the Central Landfill have been greater than originally estimated, and

WHEREAS, the cost of transport from the outlying collection stations is placing an additional financial burden on the County, and

WHEREAS, under the existing table of charges the charge for the dumping of household waste is but a fraction of the like charge imposed upon bulk haulers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that in order to defray in part the added cost of operation and to remove in part the disparity between charges made for depositing household wastes as compared with charges to bulk haulers a revised schedule of charges for household wastes is hereby adopted as set forth in the following table of charges to be effective November 18, 1974 at the central landfill/^{and} upon the initiation of operations at the outlying collection stations:

No land clearing or demolition debris.

No automobile hulks.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that charges enumerated in Items No. 3, 4 and 7 of Resolution No. 381 will not apply to the outlying collection stations except by special negotiated permit and that Items No. 5 and 6 will apply for the outlying stations as for the central landfill.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to give adequate notice to the public and to proceed to collect and account for the monies so collected.
