

RESOLUTION NO. 459
(Amendment to No. 403)

WHEREAS, on May 27, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners did adopt Resolution No. 403, setting the rate of reimbursable mileage for County Officers using their own cars in the performance of their official duties, which became effective August 1, 1974; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Attorney General's Opinion No. 161, dated November 25, 1974, the legislative body of Counties is directed to prescribe, by ordinance or resolution, the amounts to be paid also for reimbursable expenses, including travel, lodging, meals, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to comply with the A.G.O.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Mason County Resolution No. 403, dated May 27, 1974, be hereby amended, and the policy be established by the Board of Mason County Commissioners to pay actual value of reimbursable expenses incurred by the County Officials and County Employees which are submitted to them on an expense voucher, with the necessary receipts showing the expenditures attached thereto; and

FURTHER, that this Resolution be made a part of, and an amendment to, Resolution No. 403, dated May 27, 1974.
