

RESOLUTION NO. 469  
ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 17, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient funds in the following Current Expense Budgets; land

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sums will be required to meet them:
