

RESOLUTION NO. 470  
ORDER GRANTING BUDGET EXTENSION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on December 16, 1974, declaring that unforeseen expenses had arisen for which there is insufficient funds in the following Current Expense Budget; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board it is to the best interest of Mason County that such expenditures are necessary, and the following sum will be required to meet them:

EMERGENCY EMPLOYMENT FUND - To balance the fund and to provide funds for three employees for the month of December, 1974. *8,782*

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Budget extension be held at 3:00 P. M., Monday, December 30, 1974, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Budget extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above budget extension in amount set out above must be appropriated, and the same is HEREBY AUTHORIZED from the Current Expense Fund, to provide for the above stated expenditure, according to the laws governing budget extensions.
