

RESOLUTION NO. 871

REIMBURSABLE BUDGET - JUSTICE COURT PROBATION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on March 13, 1978, stating anticipated revenue is expected from Federal and State funds and these funds are needed for proposed projects for Law Enforcement and Crime Control; and
