COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 852

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 1873 known locally as the Binns-Swiger Loop Road, and more specifically located in S 27, T 20N, R 3 WWM, M.P. 2.71 to M.P. 2.27, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 306 on the officially adopted county annual road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to

Make minor relocation improvement

Vertical & Horizontal alignment & Pave with LBST

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor) (~~contract~~) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided, and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
