COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 855

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 1550 known locally as the Lynch Road, and more specifically located in Sec 8, Twn 19N, R 3 WWM, M.P. 0.73 to M.P. _____, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted county annual road program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned # 309 thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to construct an on-grade railroad crossing signalization in conjunction with Burlington Northern Railroad.

\$4,500. - Federal Funds
500. - County Funds

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor)&(contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
