

RESOLUTION NO. 889

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION - Juvenile Court

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing adopted by the undersigned on June 6th, 1978, declaring there were insufficient funds in the 1978 Juvenile Court Budget to cover cost for the detention of minors for the remainder of the calendar year 1978; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the requested Emergency Budget Extension in the following amount:

\$5,000.00 for detention of minors

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on Said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A.M., June 19th, 1978, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in the above amount must be appropriated, for the above purposes.
