RESOLUTION CALLING ELECTION FOR DETERMINATION OF SOCIAL SECURITY COVERAGE

IT APPEARING to the Board of Mason County Commissioners that a large number of Mason County Employees are desirous of determining whether they should remain under Social Security Coverage, and

WHEREAS, the question of increased payroll deductions and employer contributions pursuant to the 1977 Social Security Law poses a substantial economic impact on all parties concerned;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that there shall be an election among Mason County Employees pursuant to RCW 41.48.050(1)(i) as to whether said employees shall remain under coverage of the Social Security System and that said election shall be held on November 30, 1978.
