

RESOLUTION No. 948

AMENDMENT - Pickering Road #2885

(State Hwy. 3 - to Hartstene Island Bridge)

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956 as 35 miles per hour except certain roads as otherwise posted, and

WHEREAS, On November 5, 1962, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on the Pickering Road #2885 (State Hwy 3, to Hartstene Island Bridge) listed the road as necessary for posting at the 35 miles per hour speed limit, and



THEREFORE, by petition from residents using the Pickering Road and per resume findings from the Right of Way Agent as follows:

"With the exception of the area northwesterly of the Spencer Lake Tavern, to a point southerly of the new fire hall (Strong Road Intersection) the road design and sight distance allows for an increase of the existing 35 mph, to the requested 45 mph. The excepted area allows for a speed limit of 35 mph, together with the existing recommended speed limits as now installed on the curve signs through this area."

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said portion of Pickering Road No. 2885 (State Hwy. 3, to Hartstene Island Bridge) is amended and that portion of Road posted at 45 miles per hour effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 45 miles per hour signs in conformity herewith.
