

RESOLUTION NO. 949

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the Undersigned on the 4th day of December, declaring there was need for expenditures to cover retroactive pay increases from January 1st, 1978 as well as employer paid "Retirement and Social Security" in the Sheriff's Department and;

WHEREAS, the request is the result of labor negotiations not finalized in 1978, and;

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the Emergency Budget Extension in the following amount:

\$16,937.67 to cover retroactive pay increases from January 1st, 1978 as well as employer paid "Retirement and Social Security"

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:00 A.M., December 18, 1978 at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Extension in amount of \$16,937.67 must be appropriated for the above purpose.
