

## Order to do Work by Day Labor

WHEREAS, on June 18, 1979, the Board of Mason County Commissioners did open bids on CRP 883, Mason Lake, Mason Lake Estates, to construct a driving surface of Bituminous Surface Treatment, advertised pursuant to RCW 36.77.020; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer's estimate was for \$33,044.48, and the only bid received was for \$41,175.00, which is twenty-five percent (25%) over the estimate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 36.77.050, the Board did reject this bid because of the ten percent (10%) limitation; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of RCW 36.40.180, an emergency is declared because of the condition of the road to be surfaced and the length of time necessary to re-advertise and the unreasonable bid received;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that for the health, welfare and protection of the travelling public, the County Engineer is hereby ordered to construct the Bituminous Surface Treatment using County Forces and to proceed with this work immediately.
