

RESOLUTION NO. 1061

EMERGENCY BUDGET EXTENSION

CURRENT EXPENSE - BOARD OF EQUALIZATION CATEGORY

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on the 8th day of October, 1979, declaring there was need for extending the Current Expense Budget to provide monies for the Board of Equalization due to the heavy work load created by the assessment valuation survey, and;

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Budget Extension be held at 11:30 a.m., October 22, 1979, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Budget Extension, and;


WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of County Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County that provision be made for the Emergency Budget Extension in the following amount:

\$12,500 to be extended to the Current Expense Miscellaneous Fund, Board of Equalization Category;
