

RESOLUTION NO. 971

WHEREAS, on December 28, 1978, the County Commissioners were advised the County Treasurer had received the amount of \$593,859.38 in Federal Forest Funds, representing the period October 1, 1977 through September 30, 1978; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to allocate 50% of these funds to the Mason County School Districts and 50% to the Mason County Road Fund; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 1979, the Board did receive from the Superintendent of Educational Service District No. 113, his recommendations for the distribution of the 50% which goes to the various school districts of Mason County, in total amount of \$296,929.69, and to make the following distribution of \$296,929.69 to the Mason County School District Funds as follows:
