COUNTY ROAD PROJECT No. 879

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 0165 known locally as the Beeville Road, and more specifically located in SW 1/4, S 26, Twn 21N, R 6WWM, M.P. 3.165 +/- to M.P. 3.175 +/-, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted county annual road program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned #306 thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to

replace (Palmer Bridge) a wooden bridge with a metal culvert structure.

and that said work is to be performed by (~~any other~~) (contract) in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:


