

RESOLUTION NO. 975

WHEREAS, the cost of labor, equipment and materials necessary for culvert installation has increased since 1974; and,


WHEREAS, according to Resolution No. 428, adopted on the 26th day of August, 1974, the unit price of \$7.50 per linear foot for twelve-inch diameter culvert pipe was established to cover the cost to construct an approach to a County road out to the limit of the County right-of-way by the Mason County Road Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Mason County Road Department is now experiencing installation costs above and beyond these rates and must increase the base cost of these installations to cover the cost of the labor, equipment and materials.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the cost for installation of a twelve-inch culvert completed by Mason County maintenance forces be established at \$10.50 per linear foot, effective as of March 1, 1979.
