

RESOLUTION NO. 982

OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

Belfair Park to Tahuya Road

WHEREAS, Mason County contemplates the relocation to County Arterial Standards, 2.03 miles of County Road No. 9750, known as Belfair Park to Tahuya Road, from the Elfendahl Road, No. 8061, westerly to the Tahuya River bridge, all lying in Sections 32 (partial), 33 and 34 (partial), Township 23 North, Range 2 West, W.M., by clearing, grubbing, grading, draining, surfacing and paving with asphalt concrete and other work; and

WHEREAS, right-of-way is to be secured through State Trust Lands; and

WHEREAS, this proposal has been determined to not have a significant adverse impact upon the environment; and

WHEREAS, this proposal has been identified as not lying within waters under the jurisdiction of the Mason County Shoreline Master Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that any person who may desire a public hearing to be held in this matter shall so request in writing to the Board of Mason County Commissioners at the Courthouse in Shelton on or before April 26, 1979.
