

RESOLUTION NO. 1104

EMERGENCY BUDGET APPROPRIATION

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing, adopted by the undersigned on the 17th day of December, 1979, declaring there was need for appropriating funds to the Mason County Clerk's Budget to provide monies to cover costs involved in hiring an additional court clerk temporarily due to a heavy trial calendar, and;


NOW, THEREFORE, in the judgment of the Board the above Emergency Budget Appropriation in the amount of \$250.00 must be appropriated for the above purpose.


