WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 7521 known locally as the Tahuya
River Valley Road, and more specifically located in Sec 5, T22N, R 2WWM
Sec 5, T22N, R 2WWM, M.P. _____ to M.P. _____, work
defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to
be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted county
annual road program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned # 128 thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is
their intention to do preliminary engineering

and that said work is to be performed by (day labor) (~~contract~~) in accordance with
the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as
adopted by Mason County.
