EMERGENCY BUDGET APPROPRIATION

SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing adopted by the undersigned on the 24th day of March, 1980, declaring there was a need for appropriating funds to the Sheriff's Department Budget to provide monies to cover costs involved in hiring two Security Officers to be in compliance with the State Jail Commission's standards, and;

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a Hearing on said Emergency Appropriation be held at 1:30 p.m. March 31st, 1980, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the Emergency Appropriation, and;




