RESOLUTION NO. 1139

Amendment To

Design Standards and Specifications For Plat Roads

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted a design standard and specifications for plat roads on August 4, 1969, Resolution No. 32; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 32, was amended on September 25, 1972; and,

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to again amend said resolution to include the specifications for cross culverts to a minimum of eighteen (18) inch diameter, and the driveway access culverts will remain at a twelve (12) inch minimum diameter.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Page 4 of Resolution No. 32, dated August 4, 1969, and amended September 25, 1972, under the section "Culverts" will hereafter read as follows:

*Culverts - 12" minimum diameter for access driveways, sized adequately, in the opinion of the County Engineer, to accomodate runoff.

18" minimum diameter for cross culverts, sized adequately, in the opinion of the County Engineer, to accomodate runoff.

Submit hydrologic-hydraulic analysis for significant runoff and for critical situations.

<u>Materials</u>: Reinforced concrete, corrugated aluminum, corrugated steel. (Metal culverts shall be asphalt-coated whenever they will be, in the opinion of the County Engineer, subjected in service to acid conditions.)
