

RESOLUTION OF ESTABLISHMENT NO. 1148

(Plat of Lakeland Village No. 8)


WHEREAS, on April 7, 1980, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish "all roads dedicated to the public" in the Plat of Lakeland Village No. 8, as recorded in Volume 10, Pages 17-18, records of Mason County, Washington as County Roads; and,


WHEREAS, after due Notice and Public Hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report submitted by the Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable;




