

RESOLUTION NO. 1149

EMERGENCY BUDGET APPROPRIATION

TREASURER

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing adopted by the undersigned on the 14th day of April, 1980, declaring there was a need for appropriating funds to the Treasurer's Budget to provide monies to cover costs involved in the extra hours of work her employees did in preparing and getting ready for mail the 1980 tax statements, and;


\$1,414.38 to be appropriated to the Mason County Treasurer's Budget for salaries and wages;




