

RESOLUTION NO. 1196

EMERGENCY BUDGET APPROPRIATION

COURTHOUSE MAINTENANCE & REPAIR

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing adopted by the undersigned on the 4th day of August, 1980, declaring there was a need for appropriating funds to the Courthouse Maintenance and Repair Budget to provide monies to cover the costs involved in the construction of a new roof for the Belfair Substation owned by Mason County; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a hearing on said appropriation be held at 11:30 a.m. on August 11th, 1980, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the appropriation; and




\$11,493.03 be transferred to the Courthouse Maintenance and Repair Fund from Cumulative Reserve #1 Fund;
