

RESOLUTION NO. 1203

EMERGENCY BUDGET APPROPRIATION

MEMORIAL BUILDING BUDGET

WHEREAS, according to a Notice of Hearing adopted by the undersigned on the 11th day of August, 1980, declaring there was a need for appropriating funds to the Memorial Building Budget, Non-Departmental section of the Mason County 1980 Budget, to provide monies to cover the costs involved in paying a fuel bill in the amount of \$286.34; and

WHEREAS, it was ordered that a public hearing on said appropriation be held at 11:30 a.m. on Monday, August 18, 1980, at a regular session of the Board, at which time and place no one appeared to object to the granting of the appropriation; and


WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Mason County Board of Commissioners it is in the best interest of Mason County and the veterans of Mason County that the following provision be made for the appropriation in the following amount and manner:

\$286.34 be transferred to the Memorial Building Budget, Non-Departmental section of the Mason County Budget from the Current Expense Fund

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the above-listed appropriation in the amount of \$286.34 must be appropriated for the above-stated purpose.
