Speed Limits

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956, as 35 miles per hour except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, existing conditions on the following roads do warrant speed limits as follows:
