

RESOLUTION NO. 1216

RESOLUTION OF ESTABLISHMENT  
of  
COUNTY ROADS

(Plat of Oak Park, Division 6)

WHEREAS, on August 18, 1980, the Board of County Commissioners did pass and approve a Resolution of Intention to Establish "all roads dedicated to the public in the Plat of Oak Park, Division 6", as recorded in Volume 10, Pages 21-22, records of Mason County, Washington, as County Roads; and,

WHEREAS, after due Notice and Public Hearing, pursuant to law, and after careful consideration and study of the report submitted by Mason County Engineer, finds that the establishment is a public necessity and practicable; and,

WHEREAS, the Plat of Oak Park, Division 6, has been approved and filed with the Mason County Auditor;




Birch Place	0.03 mi.


