

RESOLUTION NO. 1217

SPEED LIMIT - PLAT OF OAK PARK
Divisions 1 thru 6

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on January 9, 1956, as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said Resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all County roads, unless otherwise posted; and,




WHEREAS, existing conditions within the Plat of Oak Park do warrant a speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour on all roads within the Plat of Oak Park, as listed below:
