

RESOLUTION NO. 1280

FORMATION OF SINGLE ROAD DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Mason County has heretofore been divided into three county road districts coincident with commissioners' district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the population growth in Mason County has resulted in an imbalance of revenues versus work requirements for the three county road districts; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public for the county road division to be administered in the most efficient and economical manner possible; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public that the county road division shall be able to provide county-wide services balanced on revenues, need and priorities; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.75.060 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners, by majority vote, to create one county-wide road district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mason County Road Division is hereby formed into one single road district, the boundaries of which shall be the boundaries of the entire unincorporated area of Mason County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mason County Engineer shall have supervision under the direction of the Board of County Commissioners, of establishing, laying out, examining, surveying, constructing, altering, repairing, improving and maintaining county roads and such other functions as are provided by RCW 36.75.050 and RCW 36.80.030;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that one taxing district shall be created through the consolidating of the three (3) taxing districts for purposes of the 1981 assessment for the collection of 1982 taxes, which shall be entitled County Road District. Monies levied for road purposes shall continue to be credited and deposited to the County Road Fund;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that regular property tax payable in 1982 for the one (1) consolidated taxing district shall not exceed 106% of the sum of the amounts of the road taxes levied in the three prior road districts in the highest of the three (3) most recent years in which such taxes were levied in such districts, plus additional dollar amounts calculated by multiplying the increased and assessed value in each component district resulting from new construction and improvements to property by the regular property tax rate of each component district for the preceding year pursuant to RCW 84.55.020;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be filed with the County Auditor and County Assessor in order to set forth the newly established taxing district pursuant to RCW 84.09.030;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this is an emergency measure, and will become effective January 1, 1981.
