

RESOLUTION NO. 1285

SPEED LIMIT LOWERING - ISLAND LAKE DRIVE

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by resolution on January 9, 1956, as 35 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and


WHEREAS, on November 5, 1962, said resolution was amended to fix the maximum speed limit of 45 miles per hour on all county roads, unless otherwise posted; and


WHEREAS, existing conditions on Island Lake Drive, County Road Number 5130, do warrant a speed limit of 25 miles per hour;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said road be posted at 25 miles per hour, effective immediately, and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary 25 miles per hour signs on said road in conformity herewith.


