COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 101-84

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1006- Revised

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 52210, known locally as the Mason Lake Road, and more specifically located from McEwan Prairie to St. Andrews Drive, M.P. 1.23 to M.P. 2.22, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 12 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to grade, drain and surface with asphalt concrete, Class "B". Revised C.R.P. to reflect construction costs.

and that said work is to be performed by contract in accordance with (day labor/contract) the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Preliminary Engineering	\$ 14,000
Engineering Construction	\$ 10,780
Right-of-Way	\$ 10,000
Road Construction	\$ 154,000
Bridge Construction	\$

Engineer's Estimate in detail is on file in the office of the County Engineer.

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
