SPEED LIMIT

PURDY CUT-OFF ROAD (Mason Co. Road No. 41780)

WHEREAS, the speed limits on County roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution on April 20, 1981, as 50 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, due to the failure of the Skokomish River bridge on SR 106 the Purdy Cut-Off Road is being used as a detour route; and

WHEREAS, existing conditions on the Purdy Cut-Off Road (Co. Road No. 41780), Mile Post 0.00 to Mile Post 2.77, the total length of the road, warrants a speed limit of 35 miles per hour;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the speed limit of 35 miles per hour is effective immediately on the Purdy Cut-Off Road, as referenced above, and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary speed limit signs in conformity herewith.
