COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 106-84

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1033

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 1550, known locally as the Lynch Road, and more specifically located in _____, M.P. 1.20 to M.P. 2.75, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted County Annual Road Program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned # ---- thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to reconstruct by grading, draining and surfacing with asphalt concrete.

(This project is included as Item 53 in the 1985 - 1990 Six Year Program)

and that said work is to be performed by Contract in accordance with the (day labor/contract) Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

The County Road Project herein described is HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
