COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1035

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 9010, known locally as the Shelton-Matlock-Brady Road, and more specifically located in _____, M.P. 3.08 to M.P. 7.20, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is hereby made a part of the officially adopted County Annual Road Program pursuant to RCW 36.81.130 and assigned # --- ** thereon.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to perform preliminary engineering: State Agency Cost \$ 3,000
Co. Prel. Eng'r. Cost: 10,000
Consultant costs: 50,000

For the purpose of desining for grading, draining & surfacing -- Road Improvement.
** This project is included as Items 17 & 19 in the 1985 - 1990 Six Year Program.
and that said work is to be performed by Co. Forces/Consult. in accordance with the (day labor/contract) Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
