COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 57-84

COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 983 - Revised

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 52210, known locally as the Mason Lake Road Road, and more specifically located in S. 13, T. 21N, R. 3W, W.M., M.P. 5.02 to M.P. 6.12, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper, and

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 14 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to

Perform preliminary Engineering for the purpose of securing right-of-way and perform road construction from Emerald Lake to Mason Lake Est. by contract. County forces to apply B.S.T.

and that said work is to be performed by Day Labor & Contract in accordance with (day labor/contract) the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
