SPEED LIMIT
MASON COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington were fixed by Resolution on April 20, 1981, as 50 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,


WHEREAS, existing conditions on a portion of the Eells Hill Road (County Road No. 50850) from Mile Post 5.75 to Mile Post 7.63 warrants a speed change;


THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the recommended speed limit of: 25 m.p.h. (from Mile Post 5.75 to Mile Post 7.63) on the Eells Hill Road is effective immediately and the County Engineer is directed to erect the necessary speed limit signs in conformity herewith.
